

# INSTALLATION / OPERATION / MAINTENANCE MANUAL FOR TYPE 30, 30A, 30S FLOWGRID™ FILTER

## SCOPE

This manual provides installation, operation and maintenance instructions for the **TYPE 30** /30A /30S FLOWGRID™ FILTERS. Instructions for the FLOWGRID™ VALVE and PILOT will be found in separate manuals.

#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The TYPE 30 / 30A / 30S FLOWGRID™ FILTER is designed to remove dirt and other particulates in the pilot supply that could affect the restrictor or variable orifice in the pilot. The Filter can be used in a variety of other gas and liquid applications.

#### INSTALLATION

The following instructions apply to mounting the TYPE 30 / 30A / 30S FLOWGRID™ FILTER on the FLOWGRID™ VALVE and connecting to the pilot system. Refer to the FLOWGRID™ VALVE and PILOT I/O/M manuals for installation instructions and start up procedures.

# **WARNING**

Personal injury, equipment damage, or leakage due to explosion of accumulated gas or bursting of pressure containing parts may result if this FILTER is overpressured or is installed where service conditions could exceed the limits given in the specification of this manual or on the nameplate, or where conditions exceed any ratings of the adjacent piping or piping connections. Verify the limitations of both valve and pilot to ensure neither device is overpressured. To avoid such injury or damage, provide pressure relieving or pressure limiting devices (as required by Title 49, Part 192, of the U.S. code of Federal Regulations, by the National Fire Codes of the National Fire Protection Association, or by other applicable codes) to prevent service conditions from exceeding those limits. Additionally, physical damage to the valve/regulator could break the pilot or filter off the main valve, causing personal injury and/or property damage due to explosion of accumulated gas. To avoid such injury and damage, install the filter in a safe location.

- **1. PERSONNEL:** Installation of the Filter should be made by qualified personnel familiar with high pressure piping and pilot operated regulators.
- **2. PRIOR INSPECTION:** Inspect the Filter for any damage that might have occurred in shipping. Make sure the body, pilot lines, and inlet piping are clear and free of foreign material.
- **3. ORIENTATION:** The TYPE 30 /30A / 30S FLOWGRID™ FILTER should be installed with the Drain Plug down to allow drainage of liquids that may accumulate in the Filter Housing (Refer to Figure 2, page 2).
- 3. FILTER MOUNTING: Apply pipe dope to a 1/4-inch NPT Schedule 80 seamless pipe nipple and mount filter by connecting the INLET connection on the filter to the body tap on the FLOWGRID™ VALVE.
- **4. FILTER OUTLET:** Run 3/8 inch tubing or 1/4-inch pipe from the filter OUTLET port to the IN-LET side of the the restrictor in the pilot system of the regulator. The TYPE 30 / 30A / 30S FILTER has two OUTLET ports for ease of tubing. Block the other port with the plug provided.

NOTE: To avoid galling when stainless steel to stainless steel connections are made use a lubricant (such as NEVER SEEZ by Bostik,). For best results <u>LIGHTLY</u> lubricate the *female* threads. Mixing the lubricant with pipe dope is also acceptable. Do not exceed more than 1/4 turn past the point the threads start to bind.

# START UP AND OPERATION


The TYPE 30 /30A / 30S FLOWGRID™ FILTER does *NOT* require any special start up procedures. Start up of the FLOWGRID™ FILTER should be made by qualified personnel familiar with high pressure systems and pilot operated regulators. Consult the instruction manual for the valve and pilot being used. Some valves and pilots can be damaged if not installed and put into operation correctly.

### MAINTENANCE

Filter element is subject to plugging and must be inspected and replaced as necessary. The frequency of inspection and replacement of the filter element depends on severity of service conditions and the length of time in service.

# **WARNING**

Before disassembly make sure the regulator and filter have been isolated from the process by closing block valves on the inlet and outlet sides of the regulator. Safely release pressure and process fluid from body and pilot system. Failure to properly complete these steps may result in personal injury and property damage.



#### DISASSEMBLY

- **1.** After depressurizing main valve and filter unscrew and remove Filter Housing from the Filter Body.
- 2. Inspect Filter Element and replace if necessary.
- **3.** Remove Filter O-Ring. A paper clip or other suitable tool can be used. Inspect for defects and replace if necessary.

#### **ASSEMBLY**

- **1.** Lubricate O-Ring with Parker O-Lube, (or equivalent Petroleum based lubricant) and place back in the Filter Body.
- 2. If the Filter Guide is removed, apply a small quantity of Lock-Tight, (or equivalent) to the threaded area and screw hand tight into Filter Body.
- **3.** Lubricate the threads of the Filter Housing with Lubraplate, (or equivalent Petroleum based lubricant).
- **4.** Place Filter Element in Filter Housing and screw Housing into Filter Body snugly (overtightening an O-Ring joint will not improve the seal). The element will guide itself into place regardless of the orientation of the Filter.
